AMS Objectives

- Compliance with initiative of Private International Law (HccH) (1961 Convention) to facilitate local and intercountry trade through the elimination of manual paperbased Apostille processes
- Continue Bermuda's progressive reputation
- Improve efficiency
- Increase throughput and hence apostille revenues
- Increase security over Apostille services
- Improve Compliance
- Improve audit apostille trails/archives
- Supports "green" environment

Milestones

- Canvass users for countries likely to be impacted (Jan 09)
- User Focus Group (Feb 09)
- Prototype completed, now in full development (June 09)
- Some Key AMS Features
 - Portal Based
 - Covers both manual and electronic
 - Agent registration
 - Validation (online registration and real-time)
 - Integrated to government billing system
 - Comprehensive billing
- Testing and implementation (late summer 09)
- Anticipated go live fall 09



AMS Inputs/Outs



Depending upon user choice, output of this can be:

- 1. Print document with actual seal & signatures and electronic revenue stamp.
- 2. Print document with electronic seal, revenue stamp & signatures (electronic and/or digital signature).
- 3. Electronic documents can be delivered via emailed or link for download by recipient.
